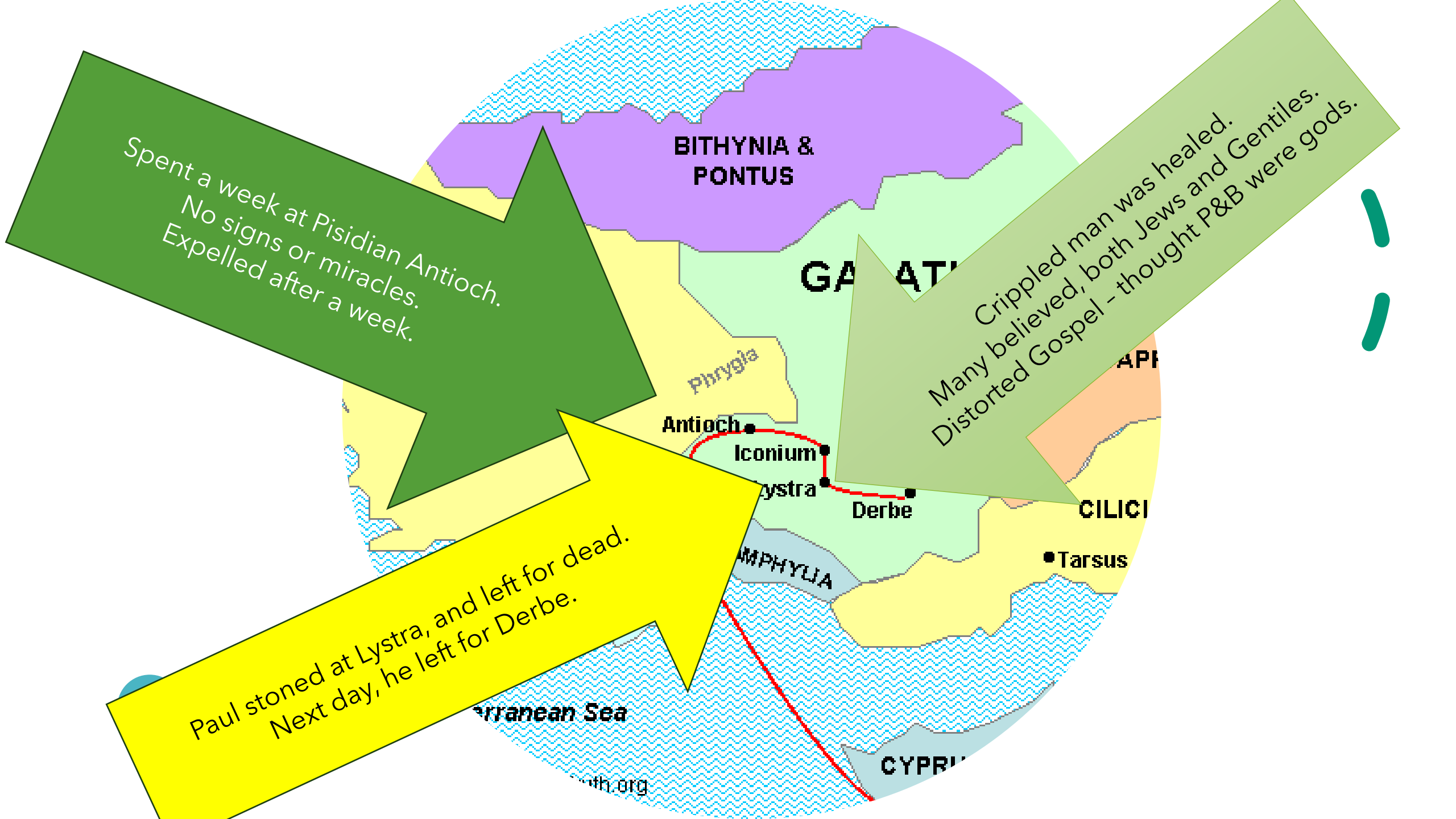

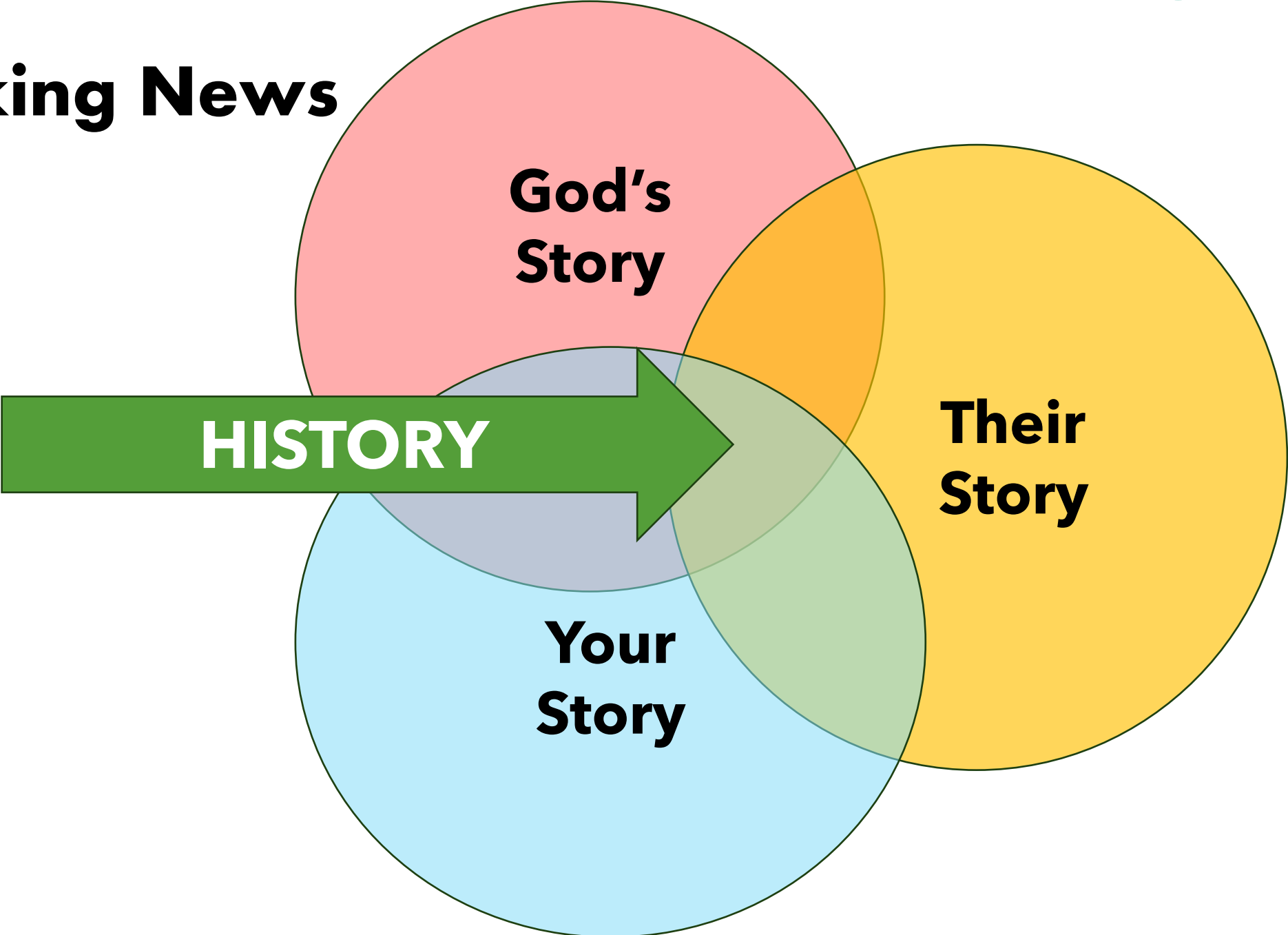

1. Breaking News

- Most people receive Jesus because of:
 - Conviction
 - Curiosity
 - Crisis.

Galatians 2:20 *I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.*

2. Distortion.

- “Foolish Galatians”.

Galatians 3:2-3 *I would like to learn just one thing from you: did you receive the Spirit by observing the law, or by believing what you heard? Are you so foolish? After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort?*

Galatians 3:5 *Did God give you his Spirit and work miracles among you because you observe the law, or because you believe what you heard?*


3. The Promise.

Galatians 3:6 *Consider Abraham: “He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.”*

Galatians 3:16 *The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. The scripture does not say: “And to seeds,” meaning many people, but: “and to your seed” meaning one person, who is Christ.*

4. Our Inheritance.

Galatians 3:14 *He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.*
