- The Rich Man and Lazarus
- 19 "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. 20 At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores 21 and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.
- 22 "The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. 23 In Hades, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. 24 So he called to him, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire.'

LUKE 16:19-31

- 25 "But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony. 26 And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been set in place, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.'
- 27 "He answered, 'Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my family, 28 for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'

LUKE 16:19-31

- 29 "Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them.'
- 30 "'No, father Abraham,' he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'
- 31 "He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.'"

Even though he is now in eternal torment he is still treating Lazarus as a lesser person.


We are all created in God's image and as such are supposed to be treated with kindness and respect!

- John 11 Lazarus resurrected
- Jesus proved that he has the power over death and is the author of life
- Plots start to form to kill Him
- John 12:9 Meanwhile a large crowd of Jews found out that Jesus was there
 and came, not only because of him but also to see Lazarus, whom he had
 raised from the dead. 10 So the chief priests made plans to kill Lazarus as
 well, 11 for on account of him many of the Jews were going over to Jesus
 and believing in him.
