I reviewed [Redacted] today (15.06.09) in our orthopaedic clinic. [Redacted] is a 51 year old lady who presented to us early last month for an injection into her epidural space. Unfortunately due to her severe scoliosis, we were not able to find the epidural space and the procedure was abandoned.

Since then [Redacted] stated that she has attended her local church and sought spiritual support. After that her pain has subsided and today she is not complaining of any pain in her back or in her right hip. She also stated that she has much greater range of motion.

On examination today, she has moderate to severe scoliosis and she has a haemangioma that is palpable on the right side just inferior to her scapular. In terms of range of motion, she has a forward flexion of 70° and lateral rotation of 20° both left and right side. She can straight leg raise both hips up to 70° without any pain.

Indeed, both her pain and range of motion have markedly improved since we saw her last. She was also seen today by [Redacted]. We are pleased with [Redacted]'s progress and we have also advised her to try some acupuncture should the pain return. Thank you for your on-going care.
